# 2025 ESO All-Star Information Packet

#### **Overview**

ESO's spring season ends on **Saturday, April 26, 2025**, and the All-Star season kicks off shortly after. Starting in early May, ESO All-Star teams will begin practices in preparation for tournament season. Practices may begin as early as **Monday, May 5th**. Tournaments begin **Friday, May 9th**, and run through early July, with a potential extension into late July for Nationals.

All-Star season offers your daughter an incredible opportunity to experience higher-level softball competition beyond the recreational season. She will also become part of the thriving softball community across the San Fernando Valley and Southern California.

## Commitment

From early May through the conclusion of the B-League or C-League States in early July — and potentially through the end of July for Nationals — families are expected to make a **full commitment** to All-Star softball.

Participation in other sports, family vacations, or conflicting activities will be considered during the team selection process.

- **Tournaments**: Every weekend beginning May 9 through early July, with additional tournaments in late July.
- Practices: Typically three times per week, scheduled at the manager's discretion.

**Important**: If you know you will have conflicts with practices or tournaments, **note this on your interest list enrollment**. These conflicts will be considered and may impact selection.

# **Eligibility**

To be eligible for All-Stars:

- Register for the All-Star interest list on the ESO website by April 30, 2025.
- There is no cost to register.
- If you wish to remove your daughter from consideration, email info@esogirlssoftball.com by 12PM PDT on May 1st.

#### Age eligibility rules:

- 6U: Players born on or after September 1, 2017
- 8U: Players born on or after September 1, 2015
- 10U: Players born on or after September 1, 2013
- 12U: Players born on or after September 1, 2011
- 14U: Players born on or after September 1, 2009

A player must meet the age eligibility rules regardless of her spring season division.

## **Team Selection**

Starting **May 1st**, managers in each division will select the All-Star teams. Typical roster sizes are **11-12 players**. If more than 22 players register, multiple teams may be formed.

#### Gold, Silver, and Bronze Teams:

- Gold Team: First team selected.
- Silver Team: Second team selected, if enough pitching, catching, and coaching exists.
- Bronze Team: Third team selected, under the same conditions.

# **All-Star Program Participation Disclosures**

Participation in the ESO All-Star program requires acknowledgment of the following:

- No Guaranteed Placement: Past participation or performance does not guarantee selection.
- **No Early Promises**: No manager, coach, or league official can guarantee placement before the official selection.
- Open to Any Team: Players must be willing to accept placement on any Gold, Silver, or Bronze team.
- **Full Commitment Required**: Attendance at practices, games, and team functions is mandatory.
- Playing Time Is Not Guaranteed: Managers determine playing positions, substitutions, and batting orders. Players and families are expected to fully support the team regardless of individual playing time.

### **All-Star Tournaments**

ESO teams will compete throughout Southern California from May through July.

- Entry Fee: Typically \$600-\$800.
- Teams must be official Gold, Silver, or Bronze teams.
- Most tournaments offer a 3-game guarantee (2 Saturday games + Sunday bracket play).
- Some tournaments offer Friday games for local teams.

#### Awards:

- 1st and 2nd place teams typically receive trophies or rings.
- Spirit awards are given after every game.
- **6U players** usually receive participation medals.

# **Championship Tournaments**

USA Softball hosts District, State, and Regional/National tournaments for 8U and up.

- ESO is classified as a "B" recreational league.
- All **Gold teams** compete in "B" Districts (unless reclassified by USA Softball).
- Silver & Bronze teams compete in "C" Districts (unless reclassified by USA Softball).

Top teams at Districts advance to States and Regionals.

#### **Estimated Costs:**

• 8U and up: **\$550-\$650** 

• 6U: **\$400-\$500** 

#### Fees include:

- Tournament entry
- Two uniforms (one for 6U)
- Practice shirts
- Insurance

#### **Additional Costs:**

- Optional equipment bags and helmets (not included in registration fee)
- \$50 ESO All Star Fee: applies to Summer Slammer staffing. Volunteering can reimburse rec season deposits.

### Fundraising:

- Teams may fundraise independently (sponsorships, product sales, etc.).
- Teams manage their own funds and expenses.

# **Uniforms**

- **8U and Up**: Two uniforms (Saturday and Sunday).
- **6U**: One uniform.
